



Assessment Pack for Non Flinders Students
Flinders Students Seeking Retrospective Credit towards their degree

Students must have attended and completed an Australian Groundwater School (AGS) intensive within the last 10 years.

Students wishing to undertake the Assessment Pack should contact the Support Officer, Okke Batelaan and include a copy of their Certificate of Attendance at the AGS. If approved to undertake the Assessment Pack an invoice will be issued, and the student will need to pay the assessment costs up front. (Full topic fee minus amount paid to NCGRT for the intensive component). The Academic Support team will then forward the assessment pack, including information, deadlines etc. to the student.

The student will complete the assignments within the Assessment Pack and return them to the Support team via [email](#) and by the due dates. Once all assignments are marked, the final mark will be provided to the student on a 'Statement of Completion'. This together with your Certificate of Attendance from the AGS can be used to apply for credit.

The assessment pack consists of 4 assessment items:

- A key terms assessment (due 2 weeks after receipt of assessment)
- A Groundwater Management of Contemporary Issue Essay (due 2 weeks after the first assessment)
- A Quantitative Problem set (due 2 weeks after the second assessment)
- A Groundwater Characterisation Study (due 3 weeks after the third assessment)

The assessment pack carries an estimated work load of 135 hours and we allow 8-10 weeks to complete.

If a student intends on applying for the topic to be counted towards their home educational institution course it is **their responsibility** to ensure that permission or prospective credit has been granted by their home institution before requesting to undertake the Assessment Pack. Aims and outcomes of the AGS are available via the web – under the topic information for EASC9700 website. For Flinders students please see information below on Delegated Authority.

Delegated authority to Credit Officer to grant credit under the following criteria for Flinders students:

- Must be enrolled in one of the Groundwater Hydrology degrees (i.e. Grad Cert, Grad Dip or Masters) or seeking admission to one of these in which case credit will be prospective.
- Must lodge an application for Credit Transfer with the College Office by using the form at: <http://study.flinders.edu.au/apply/credit-transfer>

and attach:

1. Certificate of Attendance from the Australian Groundwater School
2. Statement of Completion for the AGS assessment pack

Credit transfers are considered GPA neutral.
